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Pinot

Pinot is a modern line of chairs and bar stools that combines domestic comfort with the durability required in office, hotel, and restaurant spaces. It is characterised by visual lightness — the openwork frame made of a thin steel tube resembles a sketch suspended in space. A rich selection of finishing options allows for the perfect matching of the furniture to any interior.



Collection Features

Visual lightness and stability:

- The openwork frame made of a steel tube ensures high structural strength.

Wide range of variants:

- Models with or without armrests are available, as well as four different material configurations for the backrest and seat within a single form (lacquered plywood, oak veneer, upholstery, and a mix of these).
- The variety of finishes (veneer/upholstery) allows for versatile adaptation to the character of the space.

Ergonomics and functionality:

- A practical handle in the backrest facilitates moving the chair.
- Specially profiled, tilted rear legs prevent the backrest from hitting the wall, protecting the interior from damage.
- Thanks to short armrests, the chair can be pushed under the table or hung on its top, which optimises space and makes tidying up easier.
- Chairs can be stacked up to 3 pieces.

Certificates

- Pinot chairs and bar stools have undergone tests in an accredited laboratory, confirming full compliance with standards **PN-EN 16139:2013-07** (safety in public facilities), **PN-EN 1728:2012** (structural strength and durability) and the latest **PN-EN 1022:2024-04** (stability and protection against overturning).

Technical data

Frame / Armrests:

- Steel tube with a diameter of Ø 16 mm, powder-coated metal.

Seat / Backrest:

- Beech plywood, 10 mm thick.
- Beech plywood upholstered with polyurethane foam.

Feet/Glides:

- Plastic

Hard (plywood): seat and backrest made of matt lacquered beech plywood [PL] or plywood veneered with natural oak veneer [PV].

Mix (plywood + upholstery): upholstered seat [U], hard backrest made of lacquered plywood [PL] or oak veneer [PV].

- Powder-coated: Full range of colours according to the current Balma pattern book.

Beech plywood:

- Matt lacquer: full range of colours according to the current Balma pattern book.
- Natural veneer: natural oak veneers according to the current Balma pattern book.

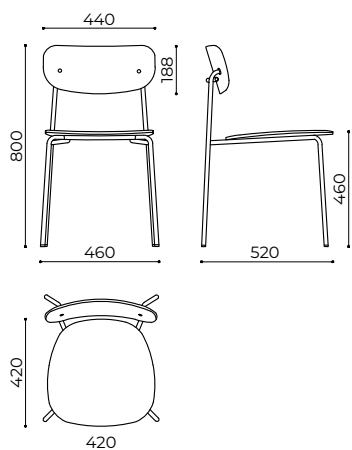
